

# COVID 19 Preparation for Local lockdown and Tier 4 closures

Dear Parents and Carers,

In order to be fully prepared for local lockdown measures and the possible closure of the setting due to government instruction. We wish to gather the necessary information regarding key worker parents and vulnerable children so we can plan accordingly.

The government have issued guidance to Schools , Colleges and Early Years Settings with regard to closures and partial closures of educational settings due to Cover 19. They have devised a tier system which relate the rates of infection in local areas. For Early Years providers we are expected to remain open to all children throughout tiers 1-3. We would be subject to closure throughout tier 4 to all but key worker and vulnerable children. We , as always, will respect individual families decisions with regard to children attending during local lockdowns etc

Guidance is being developed and changed regularly and we will keep you informed of any changes as and when they happen.

Please fill in the following declaration if you are a key worker or if you have a vulnerable child. We will aim to remain open for you during a tier 4 closure should you wish to send your child.
